



VIDEO SESSION BYLAWS

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. 2nd Congress of Minimally Invasive Surgery will be held on 15.10-17.10.2020 r. in online formula.
2. The organizer of the Congress is the prof. dr hab. Feliks Skubiszewski Foundation for the Support of Surgery, ul. Stanisława Staszica 16, Lublin. The executive organizer of the Congress is Wydawnictwo Czelej Sp. z o.o. with registered office in Lublin at ul. Skrajna 12-14.

4. The presentation of selected clips will take place during the Congress, at the designated time.
5. The administrator of personal data is Wydawnictwo Czelej Sp. z o.o. with registered office in Lublin at ul. Skrajna 12-14.

SUBMISSION OF WORKS

1. The conditions for participation in the video session are:
 - registration and payment for participation in the Congress
 - positive review of the submitted video
2. Submitted video must be original works. The work can not be previously published or presented at any other scientific conferences.
3. Clips should be submitted exclusively in electronic form, by sending the material to the general e-mail address (chmi@czelej.com.pl), utilizing one of the popular systems for transferring larger files (e.g. Wetransfer.com), and entering "Video Session - MIS Congress 2020" in the body of the message, by 1st of October, 2020.
4. The work application must contain the following information:
 - film title;
 - author(s);
 - e-mail of the presenting person;
 - institution (full name of the institution of the author and each of the co-authors, location, country);
 - determination of the thematic category of the submitted work
5. The duration of the clip - up to 10 minutes.
6. The summary should be accompanied by a declaration of the following content: "The presented work is an independent elaboration of its author / authors".



7. Submission of the film is tantamount to obtaining consent for the presentation of the work from all co-authors and the head of the unit from which the work originates.
8. Authors, whose film will be positively reviewed by the Video Session Committee and qualified for the presentation during the Congress will be notified by the organizers via e-mail, by 10/10/2020.

DEADLINES

1. The deadline for submitting clips is **1st of October, 2020**. Films submitted after this date will not be accepted. Works sent by traditional mail (e.g. on CDs, etc.) will also not be accepted.
2. Notification of the authors about the acceptance or rejection of the work will take place **until 10 of October, 2020**.

SUBJECT CATEGORIES OF SUBMITTED WORKS

- Pathological obesity surgery
- Techniques and methods of endoscopic therapy in diseases of the esophagus
- Colorectal surgery - new methods and surgical techniques
- Minimally invasive surgery in organ tumors
- Complications in minimally invasive surgery
- Laparoscopy in emergency surgical conditions
- Operations using minimally invasive techniques: gastrointestinal tract, endocrinology surgery, chest, pelvis minor

EVALUATION OF WORKS

1. Evaluation of the work will be carried out by the Scientific Committee.
2. Criteria for evaluation:
 - content, substantive value
 - originality
 - methodology
 - technical level (image and sound quality, editing)
 - mode of issue presentation

FILM PARAMETERS

1. Clips submitted for the Video Session should be prepared according to the following specification:
 - File formats: MOV, MP4



- Quality / resolution: 1920x1080
2. The presentation of the clips will take place during the Video Session, on Saturday (17/10/2020)
 3. During the Video Session, we expect the online presence of the authors of selected films.

AWARDS

There are awards for the winners of the Video Session, in form of:

- Publication and promotion of the clip and its author(s) on the MEDtube platform (in the Polish and international part thereof) by highlighting and sending notifications to the subscribers.
